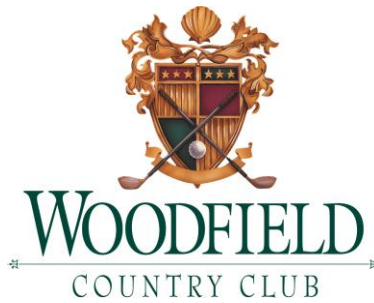

Woodfield Country Club® FAQ

How many homes are in Woodfield Country Club?

There are 1,297 homes located within 20 communities inside Woodfield Country Club.

Can I tour the Club?

Yes. Realtors are, in general, authorized to tour their clients through Woodfield. If your Realtor does not offer you a Club tour, please feel free to call us at 561-989-7272. Tours are scheduled M-F from 9:15 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Wear comfortable walking shoes and allow approximately one hour for the tour.

What Club fees are due at the closing?

- Equity Contribution payment
- Initiation Fee payment
- Prorated dues for the current fiscal year

Do the equity, initiation and prorated dues need to be paid in full at the closing?

Yes.

When is my membership activated?

Once the Club receives the paperwork from the closing, we can schedule your membership orientation. At that time, you will receive your membership numbers and other important instructions.

Who is included on my membership?

Equity membership includes the member, the member's spouse or Single Designee, and unmarried children under the age of 25 who live at home or attend school on a full-time basis.

When is Woodfield Country Club's fiscal year?

The fiscal year is November 1 - October 31.

What options do I have to pay my dues each year?

At the start of each fiscal year, members may opt to pay dues in full at a cash discounted rate, or with a 10-month Dues Installment Plan. Please call the Membership Office for details.

What are my Club voting privileges?

Standard equity members have one (1) vote per membership. Full equity members have two (2) votes per membership.

Woodfield Country Club® FAQ

Can I bring guests to the Club?

Yes. Day guests must be accompanied by the member and are subject to guest fees and use restrictions at fitness, tennis and golf. Members may bring day guests to dine and use the pool an unlimited number of times without additional charge. Members must accompany their guests at the Club, unless a house guest pass is issued.

House guest passes are available for up to four days for \$30 per person or up to two weeks for \$85 per person. A four-week house guest pass is available for \$125 per person (non-Florida residents only). There must be a 30-day break between issuing house guest passes to the same person. This 30-day break is waived for immediate family members during the holiday period of November 1 –February 15.

Members may bring guests to the tennis courts and golf course, depending upon the member's membership and dues category. Please call the Membership Office for more details.

Can I upgrade to a Full Equity membership?

Woodfield has a cap of 425 Full memberships. As long as a Full membership is available, a Standard member may upgrade at any time by paying the difference in equity and dues.

Can I downgrade from Full Equity to a Standard Equity membership?

Woodfield offers an Equity Exchange Program for eligible Full Members who wish to downgrade to a Standard Equity Membership. Please contact the Membership Office for more details.

What is the equity refund when I sell my Woodfield Country Club property?

The equity refund is 25% of the Standard equity price *at the time you sell your property*. Full members will receive a 25% refund of their Standard portion upon sale of the property. They will receive a 25% refund of their golf equity portion upon the sale of the property: 1) if they have transferability and 2) if their buyer purchases a golf membership.

If transferability is not purchased and/or the new buyer does not purchase a golf membership, then the member will be placed on the Club's Golf Reissue List to receive the golf equity refund. The member will remain on the Golf Reissue List until he ceases paying dues or until the golf membership is sold, whichever comes first. Please call the Membership Office for details.

What counts towards my Food & Beverage minimum?

All restaurant purchases, take-out food, catering and some Club events will apply towards your minimum requirement. Alcoholic beverage purchases count towards your minimum, provided that you have signed the "Food & Beverage Minimum Disclosure and Release".

Is Woodfield a non-tipping Club?

Yes. Woodfield does not allow tipping for valet services or the golf locker room and bag storage area. For dining, a 20% gratuity is automatically added.

Purchase of Membership

The undersigned agrees to pay the Total Amount Due as set forth above in cleared U.S. funds on or before the closing (“Closing”) of the purchase or other acquisition of title to a residential property in the Woodfield PUD community.

The undersigned understands and agrees that membership dues, based upon the dues category applicable to the undersigned’s membership category, will be due and payable from and after the date of membership purchase and shall continue to be due and payable until the Equity Membership is re-issued by the Club to a new member, who has paid the required Equity Contribution and Initiation Fee. The undersigned shall have all of the privileges to use the Club Facilities, for the membership category selected, as of the effective date the membership is purchased so long as all dues and other charges are timely paid to the Club.

The undersigned acknowledges that the prices of the Equity Memberships, Club membership dues, fees and charges are subject to change at any time without prior notice. The undersigned agrees to pay the dues, fees and charges applicable to the selected category of Equity Membership in accordance with the Club’s Schedule of Dues and customary billing procedures as the same may be amended from time to time.

The undersigned hereby acknowledges receipt of a copy of the Club’s Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws and Club Rules and Regulations, (collectively, the “Governing Documents”), which are incorporated into this Agreement, and agrees to be legally bound by all of their respective terms and conditions, as they may be amended from time to time.

The undersigned hereby acknowledges that the use of the Club Facilities or services incident to membership is undertaken with knowledge of possible risk of injury. The undersigned hereby accepts any and all risk of injury to themselves and their immediate family (as defined in the Governing Documents) sustained while using the Club Facilities or involved in any event or activity incident to membership in the Club, except in the case of negligence, gross negligence or willful misconduct by the Club or their employees or agents. In accepting the risk of injury, the undersigned understands that they hereby release, discharge and relieve the Club, its officers, employees and agents, and the members of the Board of Directors of the Club and any Club committee (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties"), from any and all loss, cost, claims, injury, damages or liability sustained or incurred by themselves and their immediate family resulting from or arising out of any conduct or event connected with membership in the Club and/or the use of any Club Facilities to the maximum extent permitted by law. The undersigned hereby indemnifies the Indemnified Parties with respect to all guests of the undersigned, for: (i) any damage to Club property caused by such guests to the extent such damage is not fully covered by insurance, and (ii) any fees or charges made or incurred at the Club by or for the benefit of such guests.

In the event that the member fails to pay any of the amounts due for the purchase of an Equity Membership, within thirty (30) days of such amount becoming due, the Club shall be entitled to collect all dues, fees and other charges or amounts associated with the membership until such membership is reissued in accordance with the Governing Documents together with interest at the rate of 1.5% per month for the unpaid Membership Purchase Amount and other dues, assessments and charges. The undersigned acknowledges and agrees that the undersigned has no entitlement under any circumstances to redemption of any portion of the Membership Equity Contribution paid to the Club unless and until the membership has been re-issued by the Club to a new member and all dues, fees, charges and assessments due and owing to the Club are paid in full.

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she/they have had an opportunity to obtain and review all documents and information believed to be necessary to make the decision to execute this Membership Purchase Agreement including without limitation the Governing Documents. The undersigned further acknowledges that he/she/they had the right and opportunity to consult with an attorney in connection with the execution of this Membership Purchase Agreement, and have consulted with an attorney to the extent such consultation is deemed necessary.

The undersigned agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of the Governing Documents, which are incorporated by reference into this Membership Purchase Agreement.

In consideration of the right to have alcoholic beverage purchases be applied toward the Food and Beverage Minimum, the undersigned agrees to release and hold harmless Woodfield Country Club, and all employees, agents, successors or assigns, from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, suits, debts, rights of compensation, damages, costs, claims, and demands of any kind or nature whatsoever, at law or in equity, which could arise or result from alcoholic beverage sales at Woodfield to the undersigned, or to any of the undersigned’s family members, invitees or licensees.

The undersigned hereby declares and represents that in executing this release he/she understands that he/she is giving up the right to sue or make demand on Woodfield Country Club, and all employees, agents, successors or assigns, for any claims that relate in any way to purchases of alcoholic beverages at Woodfield.

Regular Dining, Special Food & Beverage Events, Club Functions and Catered Banquets will apply towards your annual Food & Beverage Minimum requirement.

Please Note:

- The annual Food & Beverage Minimum requirement must be used within the fiscal year starting November 1 and ending October 31.

- Any unused minimum will be billed to your member account at the end of the fiscal year plus 7.0% FL sales tax.

- Golf, Tennis and Fitness programs with packaged food and beverage service will not apply towards your minimum requirement (e.g. Member/Guest Tournaments).

- “To Go” orders will apply toward your Food & Beverage Minimum requirement.

- 7.0% FL sales tax plus a 20% gratuity or delivery charges do not apply towards your Food & Beverage Minimum requirement.

- As the end of the fiscal year approaches you are encouraged to make dining reservations well in advance by calling the Concierge at (561) 995-5200.

- You may log on with your username and password to the Club’s website at www.woodfield.org under the “My Club Account” tab to view your minimum balance online or call the Accounting Department.

- Your minimum balance is printed on every monthly statement.

FITNESS AND AQUATICS
DISCLOSURE, ACKNOWLEDGMENT, AND RELEASE

Recitals

Woodfield Country Club (the "Club") is a golf and country club, which maintains facilities for physical exercise, spa and salon treatments ("Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities"), including equipment manufactured by independent third parties. An Equity Member ("Member") is a member of the Club who wishes to utilize the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities.

The Fitness Facilities may be used with or without the assistance of personal trainers or instructors. All personal trainers and floor instructors are employees of the Club. The Spa and Salon Facilities may be used only through the stated services provided by therapists and technicians. All therapists and technicians are employees of the Club.

The Club has established General Club Rules for the use of all Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities (the "Rules"). The Rules provide certain circumstances in which Member's guests and family members will be permitted to use the Club's facilities.

This agreement sets forth the agreements and understandings between Club and Member concerning the use of the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities by the Member, Member's guests and family members.

Terms

The Member understands the risks of exercise, in that by increasing work load upon the cardiovascular system, circulatory system and musculoskeletal system, there is a risk that certain changes in these bodily systems may occur during or following the participation of exercise that may adversely affect the performance of these systems. These changes may include musculoskeletal injuries, such as sprains and strains, abnormal blood pressure or heart rate, ineffectual heart function, and in some instances cardiac arrest.

The Member and his or her family members will follow all Rules of the Club when using the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities; as such Rules may be supplemented or amended from time to time.

The Member shall inform all guests of the risks and Rules of the Club described above.

Any Member who, in any manner, (i) makes use of, (ii) accepts the use of, or (iii) permits a family member or guest to use, the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities or any part thereof, acknowledges that he or she is voluntarily using or accepting such use with knowledge of the risk of possible injury to himself or herself, or to said guest or family member, and as such, agrees and does accept any and all risk of injury to himself or herself or to such guest or family member, sustained from the use of, and any physical activity associated with the use of, the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities, even if the use of the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities is pursuant to directions received from, or treatment or services administered by, personal trainers, instructors, therapists or technicians. In accepting this risk, each Member understands that he or she is relieving the Club and its "Affiliates" (as hereinafter defined) from any and all loss, cost, claims, injury, damages, death or liability sustained or incurred by the Member or his or her guests or family members, resulting from or arising out of any use of the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities.

The Member agrees to save, defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Club and its Affiliates from and against all damages, claims or losses arising out of use of the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities whether or not under the supervision of a personal trainer, instructor, therapist, or technician including reasonable

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attorneys' fees and costs. "Affiliate" for the purposes of this agreement shall mean any owner, shareholder, officer, director, employee, agent, contractor, consultant and attorneys, and any Affiliate of all or any of the foregoing.

The Club has advised the Member that any person who engages in a program of physical exercise or elects to undergo spa or salon treatments should do so only after consulting a physician. The Club has no obligation or duty to assess or inquire into the health or physical limitations of any person using the Fitness, Spa and Salon Facilities within the limits of such handicaps or impairments after consultation with his or her physician.

The Member understands that the Club does not employ or provide any physicians or medical personnel, and that all personal trainers, instructors, therapists and technicians provide no more than coaching, instruction and aesthetic services. No personal trainer, instructor or therapist is trained in or authorized to offer any medical services or advice. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERSON USING THE FITNESS, SPA AND SALON FACILITIES TO BE AWARE OF HIS OR HER OWN PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS AND TO AVOID ANY PHYSICAL EXERTION OR SERVICES THAT MAY CAUSE ILLNESS, INJURY OR DEATH.**
